Want To Better Understand Your Medications?

*Do you feel like you are taking too many prescriptions?
Are you concerned about side effects?*

If you have concerns about the safety of your medications or how many prescriptions you take, you may be eligible for our Medication Therapy Management (MTM) program.

If you qualify, you will be able to schedule a phone interview with a pharmacist, who will review your prescriptions and the reason you are taking them to make sure you are getting the best treatment for the lowest cost possible.

The pharmacist can also help with any health problems that may not have been found by your doctor and offer these helpful guidelines about your medications:

- Ways to take care of any side effects or other drug-related problems
- Information on over-the-counter drugs and how they could interact with your prescriptions
- How allergies or any other health issues may affect your treatment
